The League

Christina Battle, Sara MacLean, Juliana Saragosa, Michèle Stanley 2000-2003 – Toronto, Ontario, Canada

Active within Toronto's experimental film community from 2000 thru 2003, The League was a group of four emerging artists dedicated to working with traditional, handmade filmmaking techniques. Focusing on the experimental, the group investigated those aspects of film which make it unique; the photo-chemical composition of the emulsion, the imposed frame lines, and the overall physicality of film as a medium. The League's main goal was to create collaborative new works in an environment that was both open and supportive. By rejecting formal screening rooms, they strove to broaden their audience by presenting films in unique and non-conventional venues.

Their first collective endeavour was a Christmas fundraiser for LIFT (the Liaison of Independent Filmmakers of Toronto), which saw the creation and screening of found-footage film loops. In late May of 2002, The League completed *Elements* a multi-projection film event. Manipulating film footage gathered collectively, they sought to present the four elements of nature inside the major urban centre of Toronto. The event, held with the support of Niagara Custom Lab, became a living installation as images captured at a summer campsite were, after manipulation, uniquely presented within the space.

Collaborating with Ontario based collectives The Iris Group (Oshawa), Freeshow Seymour (Toronto) and Pretty, Porky and Pissed-Off (Toronto), The Leaque exhibited and performed works throughout Ontario at various festivals and venues including, Splice This!, Pleasuredome, Niagara Custom Lab and The Robert McLaughlin Gallery.

Geographically separated since 2003, the League is currently on hiatus with hopes to rekindle collaborations at some point in the near future.
